This fundraising event is held in loving memory of Dustin Lee James, whom we lost in 2015. At just 34 years old and two weeks after the birth of his son, Dustin was diagnosed with stage two pancreatic cancer. Last year was our most successful BBQ yet and we hope to expand our efforts this year to raise more money, and continue to bring public awareness to this disease in honor of Dustin.
